7th and 8th Grade Catechism Class with Pastor Bertram

July 27, 2023

Dear Parents of 7th and 8th Grade Children,

It is the responsibility of all Christian parents to bring up their children in the instruction of God's Word (see Deut. 6:6-7; Prov. 22:6; Mark 10:16-16; Eph.6:4). The pastors of your congregation are called to help you with this task.

How we teach in preparation for Confirmation is changing this year. I (Pastor Bertram) will be teaching a combined 7th-8th grade class and Pastor Holmen will be teaching a combined 5th-6th grade class. Each of these combined classes will function with a two-year curriculum, lengthening the overall time of instruction by one year for those attending the Wednesday classes; instruction begins a year earlier, in 5th grade. This change was made in consultation with and approval by the Council of Deacons.

Pastor Holmen and I have scheduled a required information meeting for parents and their children who are this school year going into 5th and 6th grade (non-SPL School only), and all going into 7th and 8th grade. The meeting is set for **Sunday, August 27**, after church in the **Church basement**, starting around **10:15 a.m.** There we will explain the classes and their requirements and answer your questions. If you and your child are unable to meet at that time, please contact me so we can set up a time to meet individually.

Included with this letter is a copy of the "Requirements Leading to Confirmation" from our SPL Policies. Please read this since it spells out the responsibilities of both parents and pastors in accomplishing this task properly. This will be discussed at our meeting and all families with children enrolled must agree to it before classes begin.

Those children enrolled at SPL School will have me for a teacher on Tuesday, Thursdays, and Fridays when school is in session, starting August 29. For those children attending Wednesday, classes begin September 6, lasting from 3:30-5:00 PM.

Required textbooks for my 7th and 8th grade class are:

Holy Bible (ESV) from Concordia Publishing House – you should have already Luther's Small Catechism with Explanation (2017 edition) – \$16.00; you might have already

Lutheran Catechesis, Catechumen Edition – textbook provided by SPL for your use
