



#### The "Time of Christmas" Begins

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Crooner Andy Williams sang for decades about the "the most wonderful time of the year." If you've actually listened to the lyrics of the catchy tune, you will notice that the only mention of Christmas is toward the end with "tales of the glories of Christmases long, long ago." Nostalgia and fond memories do not make for a true Christmas celebration.

Rather, what makes this time of year so wonderful are the "wonders of His love" in the conception and birth of God's Son into this dark world. Enjoy the season we are entering, but notice how the Church's carols focus on the Christ of Christmas while the world's carols focus mostly on the sentiments. If your goal this time of year is to chase after a certain feeling you've had in the past, you are likely to be disappointed. If you "come to Bethlehem and see Him whose birth the angels sing; Come adore on bended knee Christ the Lord, the new-born King," you won't be disappointed.

In preparation for the celebration of the Nativity of Our Lord, consider attending the Advent midweek services Wednesdays, Nov. 30, Dec. 7, and Dec. 14 at 6:30 PM. They will focus on a few of the "O Antiphons" of Advent leading up to Christmas, the most familiar being "O Come Emmanuel." The SPL School Children will be presenting their service the fourth Wednesday, Dec. 21. Note that since both Christmas and the New Year fall on the weekend this year, the festivals will take the place of the Sundays. The time of the Christmas Eve Candlelight Service will be at the regular Saturday time of 5:30 PM. Christmas Day Festival Divine Service is at 9:00 AM. The New Year's services (Circumcision and Name of Jesus) also will be 5:30 PM Saturday and 9:00 AM Sunday, Dec. 31 and Jan. 1.

#### **Anxiety vs. Trust**

Jesus, in His Sermon on the Mount, teaches those who follow Him that worrying about the necessities of life is idolatry: worshipping a false god. Worry and anxiety show what we care about. Our anxiety reveals what we love and what we're devoted to. It reveals what we trust in.

This is why our Lord begins this section with an overarching principle: "No one can serve two masters, for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and money" (Matt. 6:24).

But you say: "I must eat and drink. I must have clothing to wear and have a home in which to dwell." Yes, all these things you need. And Jesus says that your Father in heaven will ensure that you have them. He demonstrates this with a simple argument: your Father in heaven feeds the birds of the air, who neither sow, nor reap, nor gather into barns. He clothes the lilies of the field, who neither toil nor spin but are arrayed more luxuriously than Solomon in all his glory. If, then, your Father in heaven feeds the birds, if He clothes the lilies, how will He not also feed and clothe you, when you are worth more than they are? (Matt 6:25-33).

Do you know that you are worth more than them? You are worth infinitely more. You are worth the price of the eternal Son of God. Did the Son of God come down from heaven and become a lily? Did he descend and take on the form of a bird? No! He came down from heaven and

became a man: flesh of our flesh and bone of our bone (Gen. 2:23). He is one of us, our brother. And what did He do when He became flesh to dwell among us? He gave His holy, precious blood, through His innocent suffering and death, that you might be His own and live under Him in His kingdom forever.

God became man in Christ Jesus. He lived the life we failed to live, and He died the death we deserved. He was raised again on the third day overcoming sin and death ... for us. He was crucified for our transgressions and raised for our justification. So, if your Father in heaven has given His Son to die for us in order that we might live with Him eternally, how will He not also give us all things to support this body and life?

To be anxious about the necessities of life, to devote yourself to food and clothing, to care about these things and find security in them, is to serve another god. It is to deny that you will live forever because Jesus, the Son of God, is risen from the dead and lives and reigns for all eternity. It is to believe that the God who created you, redeemed you by the death and resurrection of His Son and sanctified you by His Spirit, will not keep His promise to sustain you in this life.

Jesus says, "Seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness" (Matt. 6:33). God's kingdom is His rule among us. His rule among us comes when our Father in heaven gives us His Holy Spirit, so that by His grace we believe His Holy Word and lead godly lives here in time and there in eternity. This is what we ask God to do for us in the prayer that Jesus taught us.

Your Father in heaven knows what you need — food and clothing, house and home — and He promises to give it to you. Chief of the things you need is His grace and mercy in His Son, Jesus Christ. So, seek after that. And those who seek will find. And all the necessities of life, our Lord says, will be added to you.

#### <u>Lutheran Church Extension Fund</u> ~ Young Investors Club

This year our school will again be participating in the Lutheran Church Extension Fund Young Investors Club. All students who at-tend our school, in addition to LCMS church members through high school age, are eligible to take advantage of this program.

Students will be able to buy "stamps" for \$1.00 each during library time on the second and fourth Thursdays of each month. When a \$25 sheet has been filled, it will be sent home with a stamped envelope. Parents fill out the re-quired information and mail it to LCEF. The student has then established a Steward Ac-count to which money can be added. In addition, up to \$50 a year can be earned with good grades or par-titivation in a service project. The current rate of interest paid is 3.5% for accounts up to \$1,000. This is a great way for students to save money for college or other long-term goals, develop a habit of saving regularly, and support churches in developing and expanding their minis-tries. In addition, various incentive prizes and awards are available throughout the year and when savings milestones are achieved.

Families receiving care at any Twin Cities area hospital are eligible to stay there, provided their children are being treated for cancer or have other life-threatening illnesses and the family resides 45 miles or greater from the Twin Cities. Yearly, more than 600 families stay there.


