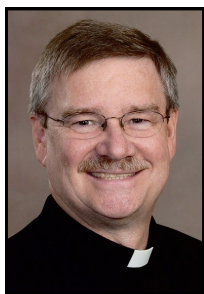

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The outpouring of care and concern for me during this time of pastoral vacancy has been overwhelming. Besides a bunch of recent funerals, the work load has not overwhelmed me, but as the school year begins, I am returning to additional duties of teaching in our school and on Wednesdays. (Keep in mind that we are currently “short-staffed” in both church and school: Pastor and Music Director.) If the vacancy continues into the winter, there will be additional midweek and festival services as well.

The writer to the Hebrews describes both the duties of a pastor as well as the congregation he serves. *Obey your leaders and submit to them, for they are keeping watch over your souls, as those who will have to give an account. Let them do this with joy and not with groaning, for that would be of no advantage to you* (13:17). I must say that, because of your love and support, I can do this with joy, not groaning.

Call Updates

Sunday, September 4, is the deadline to submit nominations for candidates for pastor. Paper forms are available at church and online. These nominations will be submitted to our District President, Rev. Dr. Lucas Woodford, who will submit his own nominations as well as detailed information on all nominations. The Council of Deacons serve as our “Call Committee,” will review all candidates and suggest names to the Congregational Assembly to ratify. Only unanimous nominations are eligible for calling.

The first call for Director of Music was returned (declined). The call committee is looking for more qualified candidates. If you have any suggestions, please submit them, keeping in mind that the position encompasses both church and school music: organ and worship leadership, voice and handbell choirs, and teaching duties. (Contact: Mr. Kube, Tyler Garrison, Chuck Northwick, Richard Eyerly, or Pastor Bertram.)

Junior Catechism Classes (Non-SPL School Children) — Welcome, Mrs. Kube!

Children in grades 6-8 not attending SPL School receive Catechism instruction on Wednesdays at 3:30 PM., starting September 7 this year. In the past, one pastor taught the combined 6th-7th grade class and the other the 8th grade class. Since we currently have just one pastor on the staff, Mrs. Lisa Kube will be teaching the younger class and I the 8th grade class. We will revert back to the old method once we second pastor is in place. We are thankful that Mrs. Kube, a highly experience and LCMS certified teacher, is able to help out during the pastoral vacancy! Thank you, Mrs. Kube!

What is Stewardship?

What is a steward? Most people, when asked this question, will reply: "A manager." That is correct, but it is only half right. A steward is indeed a manager, but he is a manager of what does not belong to him. Someone else is the owner, and the steward manages the owner's property on the owner's behalf.

We are God's stewards. Our stewardship is that God has made us managers of what belongs to Him. For we have brought nothing into this world, and we can take nothing out of it (1 Tim. 6:7). Everything that we have and everything that we are comes from God's fatherly Divine goodness and mercy. God is the owner. Not only because, as the Creator, He created all things. But also, as the Redeemer, He has redeemed, that is, purchased and won all things. It all, therefore, belongs to Him.

We are simply managers of everything in this world. Like Joseph in Egypt, we are put in charge of managing what belongs to God. What a privilege. Think about that for a minute. The all-knowing, all-powerful, all-wise God has asked us to manage His possessions on His behalf here on earth. And by doing this, He invites us to take part in the allocation of His good gifts. He wants us to give our input and advise Him in where His gifts are to be used. What a privilege indeed.



What a responsibility. For to whom much is given, much shall be required (Luke 12:48). We are not the owners. And while He puts us as managers, we are still to do with His property what He wants done with it. That means we need to know what His desire and will for His property is.

How do we know this? How can we know the will and mind of God? We find the will of God in the Bible. There God tells us what His will for all His gifts are to be used. He tells us how we are to spend our time and use our talents and treasures. He instructs us in the use of our minds, bodies, and souls.

There is nothing that we have that doesn't belong to Him. "Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, for you were bought with a price" (1 Cor. 6:19-20). He informs us of the big picture, the overarching policy, of how we as His stewards – His managers and custodians – of His property are to do the managing.

And that is what stewardship is. It is simply doing what God wants us to do with what He has given us. As St. Paul said: "Do not present your members to sin as instruments for unrighteousness, but present yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life, and your members to God as instruments for righteousness" (Rom. 6:13). So, let's dive into the God's Word and listen to what the owner desires from His stewards.

School Fundraisers

Yearly, more than 600 families stay there.
