

ST. PAUL'S LUTHERAN CHURCH
BOARD OF EVANGELISM

Our primary purpose is to proclaim God's Message of sending His only begotten Son into the world to be atonement for us and the entire world by giving His life on the cross for our sins. As Christ Jesus said in the Great Commission: "All power is given to Me in Heaven and earth. Go ye therefore and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you and lo I am with you always." Matthew 28, verses 18 – 20.

The Board of Evangelism shall consist of members in good standing in the church who are willing to serve and who have met the approval of the Board of Deacons. The board shall be charged with supervision of missionary education and:

Supervise and organize an active evangelism program within the congregation.

Sponsor periodic canvasses of the congregation and maintain an up-to-date list of prospective new members in the church office.

Provide for a systematic and continuous program of lay visitation of prospects to bring them to Christ and into active membership within the congregation.

Sponsor and maintain a systematic program of child evangelism in cooperation with the educational agencies of the congregation for the purposes of bringing the unchurched children of the area to Christ.

Supervise the work of public relations within the congregation.

The board shall, annually, elect a co-chair and secretary. It shall be authorized to appoint, annually, such officers and committees (eg: a mission committee, a child evangelism committee, a public relations committee, etc.) as necessary to carry out it's duties.

Annual expenses of the board include: local paper advertisement prior to Easter and Christmas, City of Fairmont's Visitor's Guide, and any other church publications deemed necessary by the board.
